Installation:

All Showers connect to 1/2" BSP. A typical installation requires 10mm of male 1/2" BSP thread protruding from the finished wall, plus the thickness of any wall disc's. Seal threaded connection with thread tape.

The WELS compliant Water Mark flow controller has been preassembled in the end of the Shower hand piece or Shower Head, to comply with WELS the flow regulator must remain in place.

Cleaning instructions:

The Shower is to only be cleaned with warm soapy water.

<u>Under No Circumstances</u> should any abrasive, cream or acid based cleaning agents be used as these types of cleaners will damage the chrome finish, Shower head plastic and rubber components and seals.

No.2 Drill holes to fix the wall brackets to the wall, use the wall plugs and screws

supplied or a suitable wall plug and screw for the wall material.

No.3 Fix wall bracket to wall.

Fitting, wall inlet elbow, Shower hose and Hand piece


No.1 Apply sufficient thread seal tape to the ½"BSP thread

N.B Do not overload thread as this will put undue pressure on the

Wall Elbow

No.2 Screw wall inlet Elbow to 1/2" BSP thread.

No.3 Screw Shower hose to wall elbow ensuring sealing washer is in place.





No.4 Screw hand piece to Shower hose ensuring flow regulator is in the Hand

piece and sealing washer is in the hose.
