


Installation Instructions for Raymor Undermount Sinks

Cut Out Line Counter Top

Area To Be Cut Out


Place the cut-out template into the desired location and trace around the border of the template.

NOTE: BEFORE CUTTING, DOUBLE-CHECK THE MEASUREMENTS OF YOUR TRACED LINE ARE ACCURATE TO THE SINK DIMENSIONS

Use an appropriate cutting tool for your counter top material and cut along the template line.

STONE BENCHTOP




Stone adhesive Sink

Clean and dry the underside of the counter top and then use the appropriate fixing kit.

Use the provided epoxy sink clips with an appropriate epoxy for the material of your counter top.



Ensuring the the surface of the sink is clean and dry, apply a bead of silicone around the top edge of the bowl and then manoeuvre the undermount sink into desired position. **Silicone sealant does not provide.**

STONE BENCHTOP



Sink

Tighten the wing nut onto the fixing bolt and rotate the fixing plate so that it secures the sink into place. Tighten opposite corners first and then tighten any remaining nuts.

Clean off any excess silicone and do not use for 24hrs to allow sealant to cure.

Care Instructions

For everyday cleaning of the sink, use a mild household detergent suitable for stainless steel. After each use, rinse the sink with warm water and wipe with a soft, dry microfiber cloth.

- Do not use steel wool to clean your sink.
- Wipe in the direction of the grain, along the lines of the bowl and drainer.
- Do not use chemical "silver cleaners", bleaches or detergents containing chlorine or any of its derivatives.
- Water scale can be treated using a mild cream cleaner or white vinegar and a soft cloth. Rinse with water and wipe dry.

Warning

- If the sink comes into contact with acidic materials, rinse immediately with plenty of water and wipe with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not leave rusty objects in contact with the sink. Rust can cause staining, cracking or even permanent damage to the sink surface.
- To avoid staining of the surface, do not leave food or other materials with corrosive properties on the sink for an extended period.
- Do not place very hot objects directly onto the sink. Place them onto a board or surface made from wood, silicone, plastic, etc.
- Avoid scraping the sink bowls or drainer surface with utensils.
- Avoid dropping heavy or sharp objects onto the sink surface.
- Do not epoxy the undermount sink directly onto the counter top as this will prevent future service and maintenance.
