Sanitary Compartment For People with Ambulant **Disabilities**

6/3 litre Toilet Suite



A pedestal type 6/3 litre dual flush Care Pan installation designed to provide a raised seat height of between 460-480mm for accessible applications &. The versatility of the Care Pan makes it ideal for use by both the ambulant people with disabilities and wheel-chair users including wheeled commode chairs.

Important:	Reference must be made to AS 1428.1-2009 with current amendments for people with ambulant disability requirements. The dimensions in this sheet may change with amendments to the standard.
Pan:	Concorde Exposed Trap Care Pan 6 litre full flush washdown type.
Traps:	S and P-trap unvented only. Slope of P-trap 95° 6 litre options: S-trap Code No.614400, P-trap Code No.614450
Inlet:	50mm back inlet.
Cistern:	Sovereign 2000 3 Star Cistern (wall fix version). Important: Working pressure minimum 30kPa to maximum 1000kPa flow pressure. Rain water tank compliant.
Buttons:	Round Care Button - Metal (supplied). Other button options sold separately. See section 16.01 for further details
Inlet Valve and Overflow:	Standard Bottom Entry Cistern – available as right hand inlet which is interchangeable and incorporates Quietflow inlet valve. Internal overflow only.
Seats:	Caravelle Care seat supplied, available in Caroma White (W), Sorrento Blue (SB) and Anthracite Grey (AG). See Section 15 - SEATS for further details.
Position of the Pan:	Refer to below illustration for specific setout dimensions for this suite to meet projection requirements for people with ambulant disabilities.
Colours:	Pan and cistern available in white only.
Installation:	The installation of the toilet suite shall be in accordance with the normal minimum drainline grade requirements in AS/NZS 3500.2.
Dimensions:	All dimensions are in millimetres and are subject to normal manufacturing variations. Caroma pursues a policy of continuing improvement in design and performance of its products. The right is therefore reserved to vary specifications without notice.




Note: The projection requirements for people with ambulant disabilities is 610 to 660mm.

All height dimensions to underside of pan, make allowance for mortar bedding.

Mortar bedding: The pan should be fixed to the floor with a sand cement mixture of 3:1 to a depth of 60mm. When bedded the back of the foot of the pan should be approximately 10mm above the finished floor.

Screw fixing: The pan should be bedded with an acetic cured silicone sealant and fixed with corrosion resistant screws and pan guard washers. Use Caroma pan fixing kit. Code No.601150.
